Dear mayor,

On behalf of the Executive Committee of the Global Parliament of Mayors (GPM), we kindly invite you to sign the **Global Declaration of Mayors for Democracy**.

The Global Declaration for Democracy developed by the GPM, the Pact of Free Cities and the German Marshall Fund originates from the commitments mayors made at the White House Summit for Democracy in December 2021. The Declaration aligns cities for action ahead of the second US Summit for Democracy in early 2023. The Declaration has already been signed by 78 mayors from across the world and will be open to sign until December 2022. The Global Declaration for Democracy was acknowledged by the G7 Ministers for Sustainable Urban Development in their [Communiqué](#) launched on 13 September 2022. The Global Declaration for Democracy is one of the successful GPM activities in 2021/2022. Another example is the unprecedented inclusion of mayors at the [G7 meeting of Ministers for Urban Development](#) in September 2022. GPM Chair Mayor Kurz of Mannheim, Germany, was invited to participate in the ministerial meeting on behalf of the Urban 7 Alliance which is a remarkable sign of progress towards the GPM goal of fostering multi-level governance and the GPM's vision of a future in which mayors are equal partners in building global governance for an inclusive and sustainable world.

The project "Uniting Mayors: Global Solutions to Local Climate Challenges" that the GPM organized in partnership with the British Council in 2021-2022 and brought together over 100 mayors from around the world of which 50% from the Global South, was also very successful.
